


Akaki Tsereteli State University (ATSU)

Eligibility Criteria

- ✓ A Score of 50% in required in 12th Class

- Candidates applying for MBBS must fulfill all the requirements listed in the guidelines of National Medical Commission (NMC)
- Must have Qualified in NEET Exam
